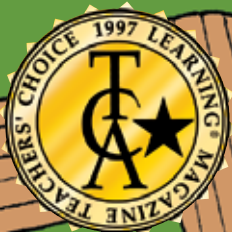

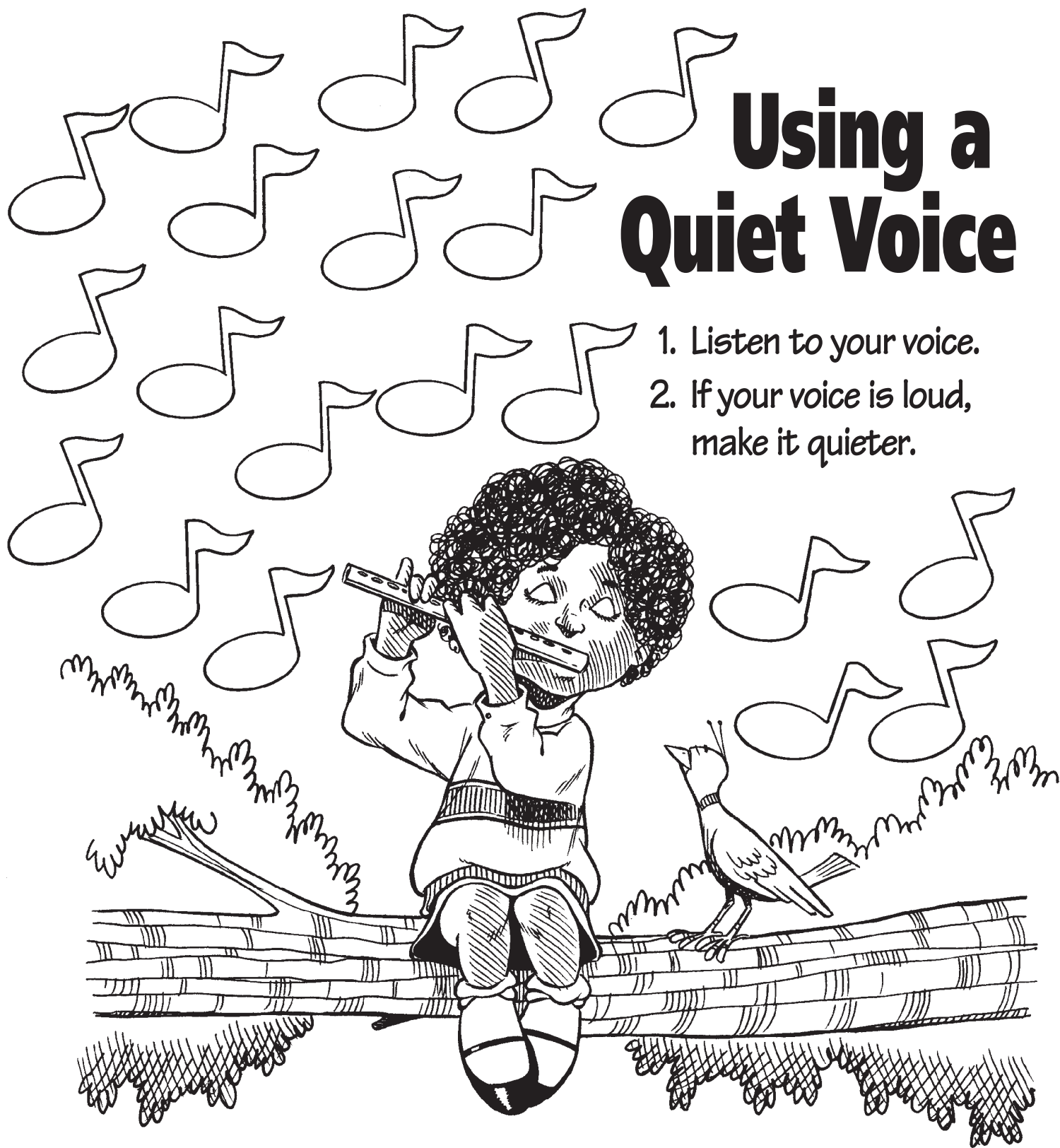

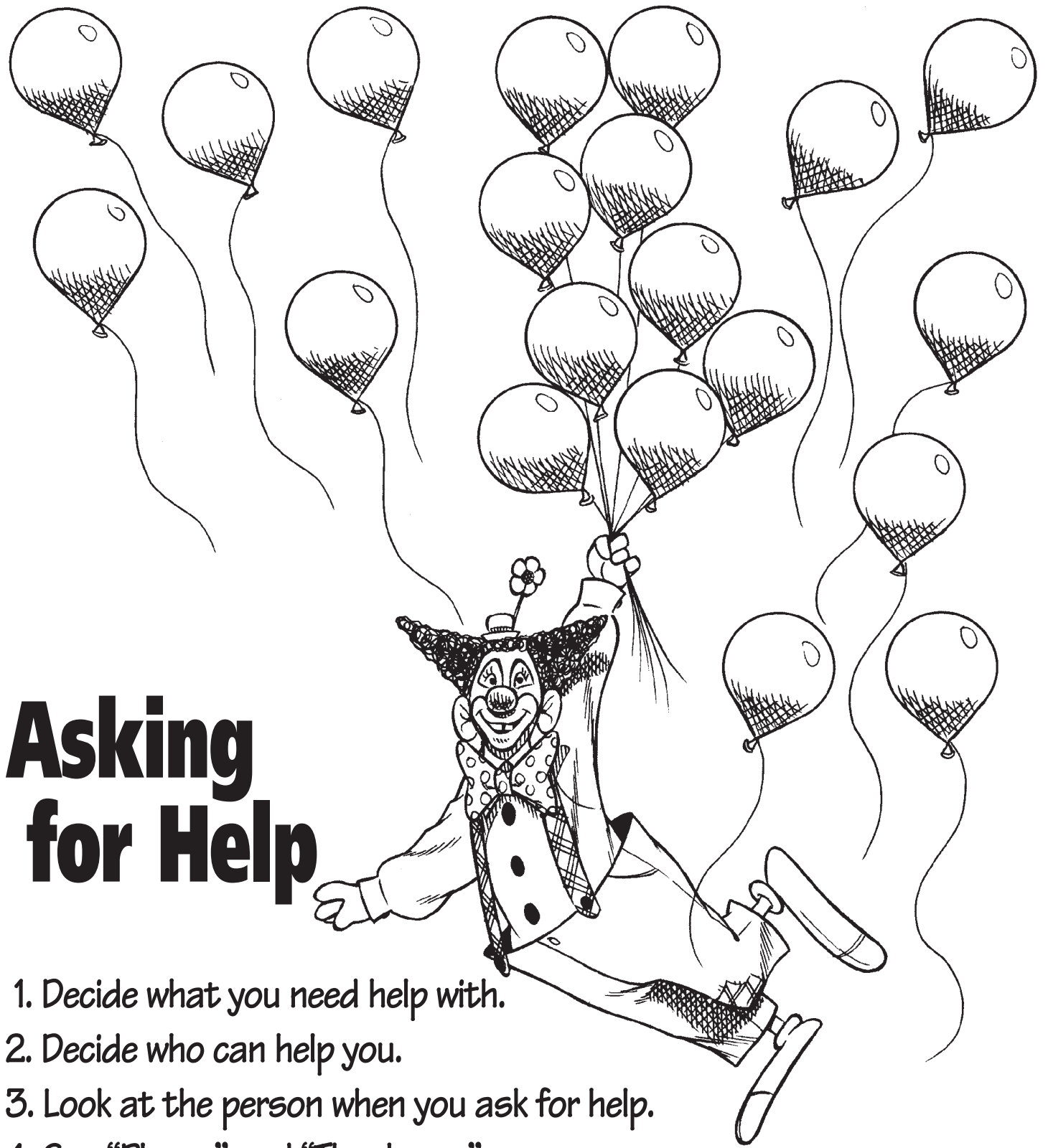
Using a Quiet Voice
